Mark D. West, CEO of Innovum, has a background in the pharmaceutical industry—another highly regulated and complex field. He says, "Working in clinical trials, one of the things I've been involved over the last 15 - 20 years was the electronic new drug application process. When I started, getting approval took figuratively a tractor trailer full of paper records and reports, which we sent to the FDA, and they would page through it as part of their review. The industry developed electronic document management, electronic publishing and other systems so we could send them the files electronically, saving a lot of time, space and trees."

Mark took those lessons and applied them to the casino gaming industry. "We can build a single database of information that is flexible enough to accommodate each jurisdiction." While there are about 10 regulatory bodies governing pharmaceuticals, there are more than 700 gaming jurisdictions worldwide. By using electronic content management, document management, publishing and workflow management to produce gaming license applications, InnovaLinq™ creates a process that is substantially more efficient, accurate and secure than the current paper-based process.
